We recommend designing your professional development strategy so that the support you are providing for employees aligns with institutional priorities.

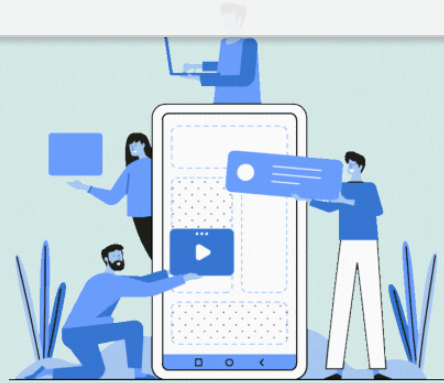
Goal-setting is easier and more effective when people can connect their learning goals to the school's priorities, especially if professional days and faculty meetings are designed to provide ongoing support for those initiatives. Here are our tips (inspired by our framework, The Folio Method) to help you maximize your summer planning to create a cohesive, meaningful PD strategy for next year:

Reflect on your progress and articulate your current position: We know that reflection is crucial when it comes to goal setting and growth. This applies to institutions, not just individuals. Spend a few minutes reflecting on your school's Folio work over the past year using our team's version of the After Action Review.

1. INITIAL OBJECTIVE: What did we set out to do this year in terms of professional development? What was supposed to happen? What were our intended results?
2. REALITY: What actually happened over the course of the year? What were our actual results? Examples?
3. LESSONS LEARNED: What caused these results? Why did it happen that way? What did we learn about our faculty, our culture, our leadership?
4. GOALS: What will we continue to do? What do we want to repeat next year?
5. EXPERIMENTS: What will we do differently next year?

Once you have a better understanding of your current reality and ideas about how to improve your process next year, begin to refine your vision for the 2023–24 school year. MyFolio End of Year Checklist (for Folio Admins):

- Check your cycle dates: All Goals, Notes (including drafts), Milestones, and Peer/Supervisor Survey Requests become read-only after the current cycle end date
- Review any incomplete Milestones via the Roll call page.
  - Tip: be sure to select "everyone you can view" from the view dropdown
- Remind myFolio Supervisors to publish any draft notes
- Delete any employees who are leaving
